## Candlewick Press • TEACHER TIPS



- Make a list of students' pets (or use a class pet) and, as a class or in small groups, research the supermom skill(s) for each type of pet.
- Ask students to write or tell a story of how a caregiver in their life displayed a superhero move to keep them safe.
- The authors use speech bubbles to convey humor. Talk about this device, then have students choose an animal to write about and illustrate using speech bubbles.
- There are eighteen different animals included in the book.
  As a class, categorize them as mammals, fish, birds, reptiles, amphibians, and invertebrates.



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
